The Committee's Terms of Reference call for three (3) elected staff members, one (1) from the University's management and professional staff, one (1) from the unionized staff of the Vancouver campus, and one (1) from the unionized staff of the Okanagan campus. Please note that for the purposes of this election, "management and professional staff" includes those management and professional staff members who are excluded from membership in the Association of Administrative & Professional Staff. It does not include Vice-Presidents, Associate Vice-Presidents, or Service Unit Directors.

Unionized staff for the Vancouver campus includes members of the Canadian Union of Public Employees locals 116, 2278, and 2950; the International Union of Operation Engineers, local 882; and those members of the BC Government and Services Employees' Union employed by the University at its Vancouver campus.

Unionized staff for the Okanagan campus includes members of the BC Government and Services Employees' Union employed by the University at its Okanagan campus.

In being elected to serve on this Search Committee, all members are undertaking a significant and somewhat onerous responsibility for a nine to twelve month period and will be expected to:

- attend frequent and lengthy meetings;
- attend in person (note that a majority of meetings will likely be in Vancouver);
- be able to attend meetings during working hours as well as in the early mornings, evenings and weekends; and
- observe strict confidentiality requirements imposed upon the deliberations of the Committee.

Please ensure that you understand the significant nature of these expectations prior to accepting a nomination to the Committee.
