- v. The candidate's list of publications (if any).

This information must be emailed to elections.information@ubc.ca by the deadline below in order for it to be made available to
voters. Requests for changes to previously submitted supplemental information after this deadline will not be accepted and the word
limit for personal statements is strictly observed.

**Enrolment Services must receive completed nominations and any supplemental documentation being submitted by 4:00 pm
on Tuesday, August 21st, 2018. Receipt of all nominations will be confirmed within 24 hours of the nomination period. If you
do not receive such confirmation within this period you must contact elections.information@ubc.ca within 24 hours or your
nomination will be nullified.**

If required, voting is expected to occur in September 2018.
