- ii. The candidate’s current occupation;
- iii. The candidate’s current and past academic, societal, governmental, or commercial offices held;
- iv. The candidate’s current professional or business interests; and
- v. The candidate’s list of publications (if any).

This information must be emailed to elections.information@ubc.ca by the deadline below in order for it to be made available to voters. Requests for changes to previously submitted supplemental information after this deadline will not be accepted. Deadlines and word limits are strictly observed.

Enrolment Services must receive completed nominations and any supplemental documentation being submitted by 4:00 pm on Thursday, 5 December 2019. Receipt of all nominations will be confirmed within 24 hours of the nomination period. If you do not receive such confirmation within this period you must contact elections.information@ubc.ca within 24 hours or your nomination will be nullified.

If required, voting is expected to occur in early January 2020.
