Here are some undergraduate research opportunities to explore, supported by the <u>Centre for Student Involvement</u> and <u>Careers</u>:

1. NSERC Undergraduate Student Research Awards (USRA)



The <u>NSERC USRA</u> allows you to gain research experience by working on research projects with a faculty member.

Position Type: Minimum 16 consecutive weeks of full-time (35 hours per week) work; terms include:

- Summer (May August)
- Fall (September December)
- Winter (January April)

Salary: Minimum \$8321.60 for the term

Faculty eligibility: UBC-V and UBC-O faculty members

Student eligibility: Canadian students are eligible - details can be found on the program website.

Application Information: Applications open annually in January. For details regarding the application process, contact your <u>Faculty/School/Department Coordinator</u>.

2. Work Learn International Undergraduate Research Awards



The Work Learn International Undergraduate Research Awards allows you to gain research experience in an academic setting.

Position Type: Minimum 16 consecutive weeks of full-time (35 hours per week) work; program is offered in the summer (May – August) term only.

Salary: Minimum \$8654.46 (inclusive of 4% vacation) for the term

Faculty eligibility: UBC-Vancouver faculty members

Student eligibility: International students are eligible - details can be found on the program website.

Application Information: You can work with a faculty member to submit a research proposal on <u>UBC CareersOnline</u>. Proposals open from November 2020 – January 2021.
