Student Questions

- 1. What are 3 accomplishments that you are proud of so far from this experience? (These could be in terms of your professional growth, related to a project, learning a new skill, etc.)
- 2. Considering your working relationship with your direct supervisor, what works well? What challenges (if any) have you experienced? How have you addressed (or plan to address) them?
- 3. Can you give me an example of how your work as a student employee has positively influenced your experience at UBC?
- 4. How is this position fitting in with your academics? What are you learning here that is helping you with school and/or what are you learning at school that is helping you with your job?
- 5. What connections have you made (peer-to-peer, professional, etc.) that may be useful to you in your future? How might you use them?
- 6. Can you give me a couple examples of things that you have learned in your work term that you think you may use in your future career? How (if at all) has this work changed your thinking about your career goals?
- 7. How did you find out about this program? What was the biggest barrier with applying for this position?
