Step 1: Check your eligibility

ACTION: Review the UBC Work Learn International Undergraduate Research Awards <u>webpage</u> for:

- Links to Faculty/School/Department for further award criteria

Call for Research Project Proposals will open on November 28, 2022 and close on January 27, 2023.

Step 3: Prepare for a possible interview

ACTION: The faculty member(s) will contact you directly to schedule an interview(s).

Step 4: Accept an offer

Your faculty supervisor will submit an appointment form to ensure you are paid for the position.

ACTION: Please give your faculty supervisor all applicable documentation to set-up your payroll in a timely manner i.e. Social Identification Number (SIN), Study Permit, and Direct Deposit information.

Please contact International Student Advising regarding any study/work permits to legally work in Canada.
