Work Learn International Undergraduate Research Awards 2026 - 2027 Information for Faculty Supervisors

Step 1: Review the website

ACTION: Review the Work Learn International Undergraduate Research Awards website for information.

- Students may contact you to submit a proposal for this award. You may work with the student to come up with a research project proposal.
- If you would like to hire an international undergraduate student to work on your research project but do not have a candidate in mind, you can submit a proposal as well.

Call for Research Project Proposals will open from **November 24, 2025 to January 28, 2026.**

Step 2: Submit your research project proposal(s)

ACTION: You must submit the research project proposal on <u>UBC CareersOnline</u>.

- Note: You will need a UBC CareersOnline EMPLOYER account to submit the research project proposal.
- <u>Download</u> a step-by-step guide on how to submit a research project proposal. After reading the guide, please email <u>worklearn.iura@ubc.ca</u> if you have any questions.
 - o If you have a student in mind for this position, select "internal candidate" on your application form.

All research project proposals must be submitted to UBC by January 28, 2026.

Step 3: Await funding decision

Your research project proposal will be reviewed. You will receive a decision on your proposal(s) by the week of **March 3, 2026.**

Step 4: Students apply for position(s)

If your position(s) is approved, it will be posted on UBC CareersOnline from **March 9 - 25, 2026**If you have an internal candidate, the position will not be posted. Proceed to **Step 6: Submit a HIRE BP.**

Step 5: Begin the hiring process

ACTION: Review student applications, interview students for the position, and choose a successful candidate. The program website offers resources and advice to assist you with the <u>hiring process</u>.

Step 6: Submit a HIRE BP.

ACTION: Submit the appropriate Hire BP via Workday by May 13, 2026.

Review the **Information Sheet for Appointing Students** on the Work Learn International Undergraduate Research award <u>website</u> for guidance. Share this information with your departmental administrator or financial officer.

Step 7: Student(s) start their research award

ACTION: Student(s) can begin work as per the agreed upon start date. Consider resources for onboarding and orientation available on the <u>website</u>.
