Supervisor Questions

- 1. Can you tell me a little bit about the work that you've been working on with the student this term?
- 2. Tell me a bit about your onboarding process. What supports/guidance were provided to the student?
- 3. What constructive feedback have you shared with the student? How was the feedback integrated?
- 4. What area of growth have you seen with your student? What has been the biggest impact on the student's learning/success?
- 5. What does student mentorship mean to you? What has mentorship to your student looked like in your department/unit?
- 6. What opportunities has your student had to engage in professional development and/or critical reflection?

Student Questions

- 1. What are 3 accomplishments that you are proud of so far from this experience? (These could be in terms of your professional growth, related to a project, learning a new skill, etc.)
- 2. Considering your working relationship with your direct supervisor, what works well? What challenges (if any) have you experienced? How have you addressed (or plan to address) them?
- 3. Can you give me an example of how your work as a student employee has impacted your experience at UBC?
- 4. What are some connections you see between your academics and your role?
- 5. Who are some people you have met in your role? How might they be helpful to you in your future career?
- 6. How has this work impacted your thinking about your career goals? Can you give me a couple examples of things that you have learned in your work term that you think you may use in your future career?
- 7. How did you find out about this position? What was your biggest barrier with applying?
